Maryann Jordan has devoted her career to capacity building within the cultural sector. Maryann serves as Chief Operating Officer for The Shed, a new nonprofit in New York scheduled to open in 2019 and dedicated to artistic invention and producing cultural projects across all art forms. From 2014 to 2016, she served as Associate Director of the Vancouver Art Gallery, overseeing Institutional Advancement and spearheading the development and launch of the \$350 million capital campaign for a new museum facility designed by Herzog & de Meuron in Vancouver, British Columbia. In 2013, she concluded her 18-year tenure at the Seattle Art Museum (SAM) where she served in a variety of executive roles, most recently as Vice Director. During her time at SAM, Maryann focused on the development and implementation of a comprehensive strategy to expand philanthropic support and community engagement in the work of the museum.

Prior to her time in Seattle, Maryann spent nearly two decades engaged in cultural management in New York City having worked at the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the New York Public Library, Christie's and as Director of External Affairs at the Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum. She is a member of the Executive Committee and has served as president of the Art Museum Development Association. Maryann also served as an advisory board member and lecturer for the Janklow Arts Leadership Program at Syracuse University and on the faculty of the Getty Leadership Institute. In 2012, she received the French Government's Chevalier de l'Ordre des Arts and des Lettres.

Maryann is a graduate of Stanford University and holds a Masters in Management from Yale University.
