



Lisa Key is the Chief Development Officer at the Museum of Contemporary Art Chicago where she oversees all fundraising and membership functions. While at the MCA, Lisa has worked on various projects and fundraising initiatives, including the MCA's Fiftieth Anniversary Celebration, the 2015 Benefit Art Auction with profits reaching \$3.7MM, and the ongoing *Vision* Capital Campaign with an \$80MM goal. Lisa oversees the Board Governance and Nominating Committee and actively assists in the strategic planning and organization of Board of Trustees and Executive Committee meetings. She is currently the Vice President of the Board at Threewalls, a non-profit contemporary arts organization in Chicago.

Prior to joining the Development team at the MCA, Lisa was Director of Strategic Initiatives at the Field Museum where she worked with the Board of Trustees to begin strategic planning related to fundraising and soliciting major gifts. Lisa worked for nine years at The Art Institute of Chicago, beginning as Associate Director of Foundation and Corporate Relations and ending her tenure as Vice President of Institutional Giving. At AIC, Lisa managed a wide-range of projects such as creating sponsorship plans for exhibitions, garnering a \$1.5MM corporate gift, to managing the pre-planning and implementation of the \$350MM *Building of the Century* Capital Campaign. Lisa has also held positions at The Department of Cultural Affairs for the city of Chicago, The Indianapolis Museum of Art, the Indiana University Art Museum, and was an Adjunct Faculty Member at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago.

Originally from Indiana, she attended Valparaiso University and later earned a Master of Business Administration degree (MBA) in Arts Administration from the Kelley School of Business at Indiana University.
