

Jonathan Peterson's unique and extensive skillset touches every aspect of fundraising and donor development, one acquired over a wide-ranging 25-year career. Currently, he serves as Director of Development for the Philadelphia Museum of Art where he is partnering with senior staff and Trustees to lead a \$425 million comprehensive campaign to enhance the endowment, advance strategic initiatives, and implement a Facilities Master Plan and expansion designed by Frank Gehry. He is responsible for a staff of 45 development professionals and all philanthropic efforts, including major gifts, annual giving, institutional giving, stewardship and communications.

Previously, as the Director of Development for the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, Jonathan successfully implemented a \$610 million capital campaign, managed a staff of 45 individuals, raised funds to support the operating budget, and oversaw the museum's membership program of 40,000 households. Additionally, Jonathan has been a critical asset to the growth and vitality of many distinguished cultural institutions—the San Francisco Opera; the New World Symphony in Miami; the Chicago Symphony Orchestra; the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra; as well as a tenure in wealth management at JPMorgan Private Bank.
