Christa Clarke is Senior Curator, Arts of Global Africa at the Newark Museum, where she has organized numerous exhibitions ranging from men's fashion to Nigerian modernism since her appointment in 2002. Clarke has been a fellow at the Clark Art Institute, the Metropolitan Museum of Art and the Smithsonian and held teaching appointments at NYU Abu Dhabi, University of Pennsylvania, Rutgers University and George Washington University. Her publications include *Representing Africa in American Art Museums: A Century of Collecting and Display* (2010, co-edited with Kathleen Berzock) and *African Art in the Barnes Foundation* (2015). Clarke currently serves as President of the Association of Art Museum Curators and, in 2017-2018, will be a fellow at Harvard University's Hutchins Center for African & African American Research.
