Arpie Chucovich is the Chief Development Officer at the Denver Art Museum. She joined the museum staff in 2009. She oversees overall fundraising efforts of the museum including major gifts, upper level membership programs, special events, and planned gifts and bequests. She is leading the \$175 million campaign of the museum to complete the DAM campus and renovate the North Building.

She holds a master's degree in Architecture from the University of Colorado, Denver. Prior to joining the DAM and since 1998, she created and implemented strategies to enhance programming, expand fundraising, and build sustainable business models with cultural organizations including the Denver International School, the Museum of Contemporary Art, and the Denver Film Society. Chucovich led the capital campaigns to expand the building infrastructure for these organizations, bridging her architectural practice into arts and culture administration.

Arpie is on the Adjunct Board of the School of the Art Institute of Chicago and the DAM Contemporaries, a support group of the Denver Art Museum.
