



Lisa M. Key joined the Museum of Contemporary Art Chicago in 2007 and is the Chief Development Officer. Lisa leads the museum's comprehensive fundraising efforts with oversight on the strategic elements that connect programs, board, and staff together to successfully support the museum's operations. While at the MCA, Lisa has worked on various projects and fundraising initiatives, including the MCA's Fiftieth Anniversary Celebration, the 2015 Benefit Art Auction with profits reaching \$3.7M, and the *Vision Capital Campaign* that recently closed by exceeding its \$80M goal. Lisa also oversees the Board Governance and Nominating Committee and actively assists in the planning and organization of Board of Trustees and Executive Committee meetings at the MCA.

Prior to joining the MCA, Lisa worked at the Field Museum Chicago, the Art Institute of Chicago, the Chicago Department of Cultural Affairs, and the Indianapolis Museum of Art. Lisa is committed to engaging the next generation of arts administrators through her work at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago and Valparaiso University. She is a Past President of the Art Museum Development Association and is Vice President of the Board of Threewalls, a Chicago-based non-profit dedicated to contemporary discourse about the intersections of art, social justice and community. Lisa graduated with a BA in Art History and Communications from Valparaiso University and received an MBA in Arts Administration from the Kelly School of Business at Indiana University.
